AP context background





- Policy Instrument
 - ➤ OP4: ERDFco-funded measure for the **support of energy efficiency, smart energy management and RES use** in public infrastructures, including in public buildings, and in the housing sector
 - ➤ Objective (4.3.1): Renovation and modernization of multiapartment buildings through EE enhancement measures
- Main features:
 - Financing of the measures increasing the EE of the buildings (heating and hot water supply and distribution, insulation) and other measures of modernization (ventilation, façade, constructions of the buildings, lifts) and RES measures.
 - Major renovation is oriented to the min 'C' EE class
 - ➤ Investments into EE of public and residential buildings: are expected to save up to 1/3 of heating energy
 - Complex renovation and proactive role of the municipalities








Motivation

- EC prioritize the EE in multiapartment buildings
- Intentions of Lithuanian energy intensive economy to change in order to increase EE and the use of RES
- It address both climate change and challenges related to environment and energy provision safety
- Investments into EE of public and residential buildings are expected to save up to 1/3 of heating energy
- Lithuanian model in buildings renovation already worked well, however the improvements could foster the sustainability of this process
- Priority Axis 4 needs improvement in order to guarantee that intensive quantitative indicators correlate with the qualitative ones.

Main vision





➤ VISION: Reduction of energy consumption in multiapartment houses, through the innovative and proactive renovation process, where the quantitative and qualitative indicators are oriented to the strategic energy efficiency, low carbon economy and other sustainability issues: social, economic and technical ones.

Strategic goal





- A. Increase of heat energy savings by the breakthrough of renovation of multiapartment buildings
- ➤ The focal points for the improvement of the policy instrument are through improved governance of the residential buildings renovation process with the high EE quality in order:
 - to speed the ongoing process and
 - > to increase of amount of the households with the increased energy efficiency class and
 - > the awareness raising to the end users.

The indicator for the Lithuania is **20.000 households** with improved energy consumption classification.
